Terms of Reference

Under the specific guidance of the Programme Officer, Coastal Zones, the incumbent will develop and implement the following products:

- Organize the Persistent organic pollution data for the White grunt fish in the Caribbean (2009-2010 data) – prepare graphs and summary charts.
- Use the meta data from this project and input this into an online database on marine and costal initiatives for the ‘Caribbean environment programme’:

- Organize the Meso American Barrier Reef project data on recruitment monitoring on coral reefs of coral, fish and lobster (2 years data form approx. 8 sites): organize and create summary sheets and graphs for on the web.
- Assist in finding statistics and data, interpreting and summarizing this data for developing a policy brief for the Arabian Gulf marine environment.
- Assist in writing and editing parts of a mangrove policy brief.
- Assist in the search for and the development of parts of curricula for a tropical coastal environment course (online).
